I. Welcome/Introductions – Katie Gallagher, Co-Chair (9:00am-9:10am)

- The meeting began at 9:03am. Amber welcomed everyone and asked them to introduce themselves.

II. Crisis Recovery Center Update – Lori Carnahan, Deputy Director of Behavioral Health, DuPage County Health Department (9:10am-9:35am)

- Lori Carnahan provided an update on the Crisis Recovery Center (CRC), which will tentatively have its grand opening in late August.
- DCHD currently provides the following crisis services:
 - 988 Suicide & Crisis Lifeline
 - DCHD Crisis Hotline (630-627-1700)
 - Mobile Crisis Response Team
 - Services include 24/7 mobile crisis response for adults and youth at location of crisis in order to determine appropriate level of care
 - On-site Crisis Evaluations
 - Services include walk-in evaluations
 - Crisis Respite
 - Services include 24/7 12-bed unit for adults who are experiencing an increase in psychiatric symptoms but do not require inpatient hospitalization
- The CRC will be a collaborative effort with community partners to provide free comprehensive assessments, rapid stabilization, and a warm handoff to ongoing care for adults and youth (ages 5-17)
 - This will be the first model of its kind in the state of Illinois and is one of the first models in the country to incorporate youth
- Individuals that live or work in DuPage County can stay up to 24 hours during a time of crisis and be directly connected with behavioral health staff to assist with stabilization

III. Reality/Teen Ambassadors Year End Round-Up – Lisa Lerner & Leia Der, Community Initiatives Coordinators, DuPage County Health Department (9:35am-9:50am)

- Lisa and Leia provided an overview of Reality and Teen Ambassador accomplishments over the 2024-2025 school year and were joined by Lindsay Seifert, a Teen Ambassador from Glenbard West High School.
- Reality accomplishments include:
 - Teens partnered with the Glenbard High Schools to listen to a keynote speaker and make blankets to donate to Project Linus (Over 100 teens attended)
 - Teens partnered with KidsMatter and Glenbard High Schools to train 18 teens in mental health first aid.
 - Teens displayed 988 yard signs during the month of May for Mental Health Awareness Month.
- Teen Ambassador accomplishments include:
 - Teens assembled an executive board with three subcommittees: Community Events & Outreach, Mental Health Awareness Campaign, and School Initiatives
 - Teens introduced several speakers and guests for the GPS Parent Series
 - Teens voted on their favorite Tik Tok ad, Live Life Well Week flyer, and gave insight for PLT's parent communication guide about marijuana
 - Teens created a Teen Resource Guide to connect teens with vital services, support systems, and information promoting their well-being.
 - Teens conducted a sticker shock campaign geared towards prom vendors to remind teens to think about the consequences of underage drinking when picking up their prom essentials
- Administrative changes for next year will include:
 - Updating the website content to reflect current goals and priorities
 - Reorganizing to be limited to 10-15 teens who actively participate
 - Further emphasizing the policy and advocacy role of teens in the community
 - Requiring attendance at the monthly virtual check-ins to improve planning efforts
- Teen Ambassador applications are open to all Reality members and will be available until mid- to late-September. Interviews will then take place in early October.

IV. Mental Health Month Table Talk – All (9:50am-10:20am)

- Members discussed their Mental Health Awareness month experiences:
 - *Things members learned/take-aways from mental health month events*
 - Professionals in the field are interested in attending other events but are too busy facilitating their own
 - More events could have spoken about the direct correlation between substance use and mental health
 - It would be beneficial to bring Dr. Singer into the schools to facilitate a roundtable with teachers and administrators about suicide

- He shared a story about a behavioral health facility that sent letters to check-in on their patients who previously attempted suicide. The results were immediately positive and identified a trend of lower levels of suicide attempts in individuals who received the letters. This signified the importance of keeping the dialogue open.
- *Strategies members would like to see PLT focus on regarding mental health*
 - Identifying what type of support parents need:
 - More education to identify the difference between feeling sad or upset versus having a mental health disorder and needing support
 - More support to talk about their personal experiences and struggles with their children
 - Providing support to parents in a way that meets them where they are at:
 - Conducting parent focus groups
 - Posting on-demand videos for parents on our website
 - Hosting virtual watch parties to debrief GPS Parent Series events
- *What could members do personally/through their organization to contribute to youth and adult mental health*
 - Being intentional in bringing back updates from coalition meetings and community events

V. Updates/Upcoming Events – Katie Gallagher, Co-Chair (10:20am-10:30am)

- **GPS Parent Series**
 - Events have concluded for the school year and will resume in August

- **Teen PhilanthroParty**
 - This year's Teen PhilanthroParty will be June 17 from 1-3pm at College of DuPage

 - Stef's Corner was developed to support teen mental health and recently received its 501(c)(3) status
