I. Welcome/Introductions – Jordan Esser, Project Director (9:00am-9:10am)

- The meeting began at 9:04am. Jorie welcomed everyone and asked them to introduce themselves.

II. Forces of Change Assessment – Becky McFarland, Impact DuPage, DuPage County Health Department (9:10am-10:20am)

- Becky presented an overview of the Impact DuPage Forces of Change Assessment (FOCA) and its role within the county's community needs assessment process.
- The FOCA is designed to help participants identify trends, factors, and events over the next several years that may influence community health.
- A reference point for this work is the [2022 FOCA Report](#) from the previous cycle.
- This month's meeting was dedicated to PLT members participating in the 2025 FOCA.
- Following a broad discussion of contributing factors, members voted on the five most significant issues expected to affect DuPage County's health in the coming years.
- The “**Top 5 Factors**” identified by PLT are listed below as the group's contribution to the *2025 Forces of Change Assessment*:
 - Cost of living is increasing, which results in more food insecurity, more housing instability, and people having to prioritize their needs.
 - Funding cuts and limiting eligibility criteria at the Federal level are affecting social service agencies' ability to provide enough high-quality services resulting in negative health outcomes for people trying to seek services.
 - Youth having unlimited and unmonitored access to social media and AI can lead to more negative mental health outcomes and increase feelings of social isolation.
 - Mental health needs of adolescents are increasing, and schools are often expected to address these needs without proper supports in place to do so.
 - Widespread misinformation can lead to distrust of science and agencies that were historically a trusted source of information.

- Next, Impact DuPage will create a Top 5 List of Concerns that were mentioned most across all 11 stakeholder groups that also participated in the FOCA process. These results will be included in the final community health assessment, which will be completed in early 2026.
